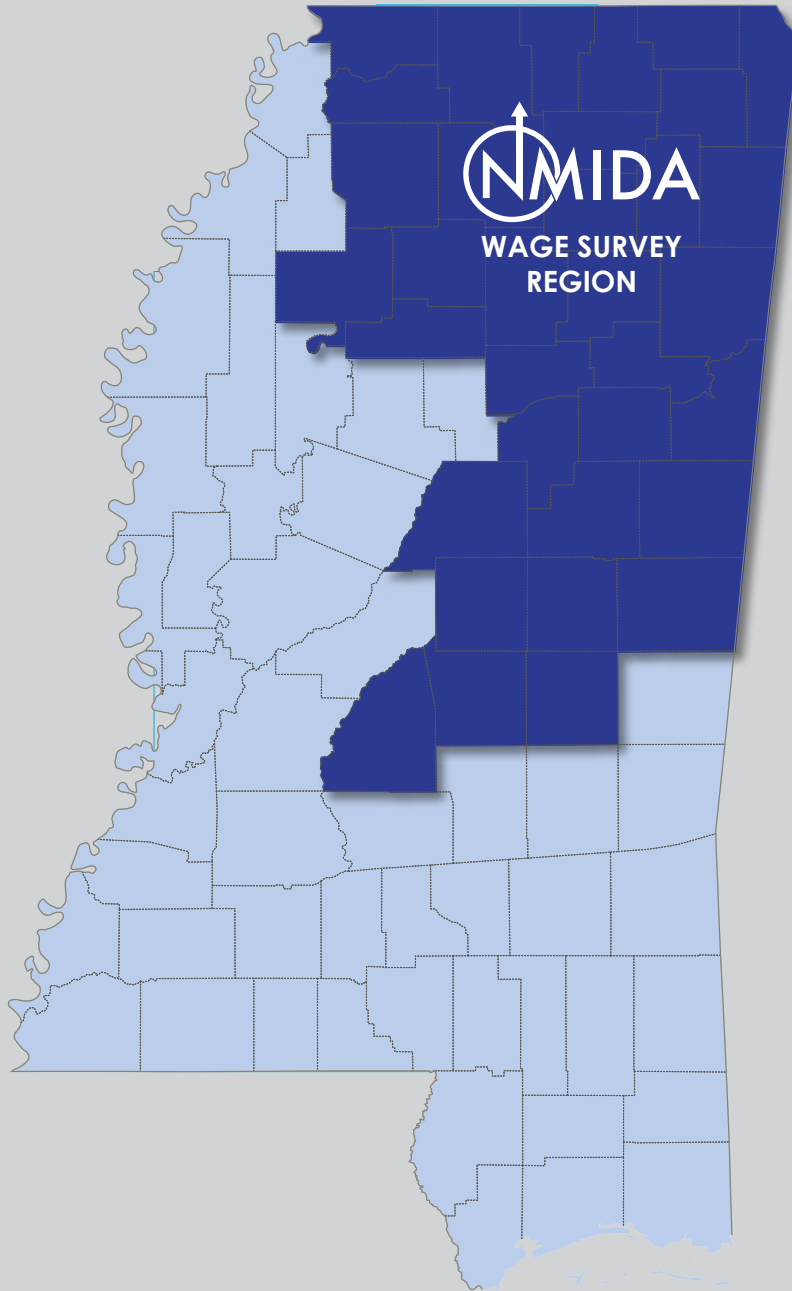

## Job Zone Description

**Job Zones:** a system created by the O\*NET project to classify how much preparation an occupation requires. Job Zone classifications are coded from 1 to 5 based on the amount of preparation needed to perform the duties of a given occupation. The table below describes the Job Zone classification system in greater detail and also gives examples of occupations in specific job zone categories.
